With every Season Subscription package, you will receive five (5) tickets to use at any of our in-person or virtual mainstage performances, early-purchasing benefits, free admission to Studio Theatre productions, and special subscriber events to help bring you closer to the arts you love. ASU Faculty/Staff, all retirees, and veterans are eligible for a 20% discount. Please call our box office at 325.942.2000 to purchase qualified discounted packages. Due to state guidelines, we are unable to issue any refunds, but we are able to exchange tickets within the season to other performance dates that are available. Due to COVID guidelines and student/employee safety, our box office phone hours are limited to 3-5 pm the week before and during performances. However, please leave a message any time or call 325.942.2146 for assistance. Dinner options for certain performances can be purchased separately closer to the performances. If you were a season subscriber for 2019/2020, we can offer you an additional two comp tickets to any performance of your choice as a thank-you for your understanding when ASU moved online for COVID. In the event of another campus shutdown, all affected performances will move to an online platform.
